









PRIORITY TO LOGISTICS, MSMES NEEDED TO BOOST INDIA'S EXPORTS

COURT UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE A&C ACT CAN SEVER OFFENDING PART OF ARBITRATION CLAUSE



The High Court of Delhi has held that the Court exercising powers under Section 11 can of the A&C Act sever an illegal/offending portion of arbitration clause. The bench of Justice Sachin Datta held that an arbitration clause does not become illegal by mere illegality of the appointment procedure provided therein, therefore, the Court u/s 11 can sever the illegal portion of the award and refer the dispute arbitration. Three petitions were filed under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking appointment of a Sole Arbitrator to settle disputes between the parties. In

the first case, ARB.P. 740/2023, the disagreement stemmed from a contract for "Execution and Handing over of Civil Works for 400 Kv Bay Extension At Karaikudi In Tamil Nadu." This work was awarded to the petitioner by the respondent, leading to a Work Order followed by a Contract Agreement

In ARB.P. 738/2023, the dispute arose from a contract involving "Execution and Handing Over of Civil Works for Land Development and Boundary work for 400/110 KV Switchyard at Thappagundu in Tamil Nadu." The petitioner received a Work Order on 01.03.2014, resulting in a Contract Agreement The third case, ARB.P. 737/2023, involved a contract for "Execution and Handing over of Balance Civil Works of 400/11 OKV Switchyard at Thappagundu in Tamil Nadu." The petitioner was awarded the work, receiving a Work Order on 26.09.2016, and a Contract Agreement

The three largest forces in the world, US Air (USAF), Force PLA Air Force (PLAAF), and the Russian Air Force (VVS), already have their homegrown fifth-generation fighters. Many other modern air forces have inducted the Lockheed F-35 and are working on sixth-generation aircraft, individually or in joint ventures.

Their second fifth-generation fighter Shenyang FC-31 "Gyrfalcon," is being accelerated. China no more needs to import fighter aircraft. India is the only major country that could still be a possible buyer of a fifth-generation aircraft. Even though India walked out of the joint Fifth Generation Fighter Aircraft (FGFA), Russia continues to hope and woo India into buying its fifth-generation fighters.

The US has not formally offered the F-35 aircraft to India, but because they brought two of them to the 'Aero India 2023' at Bengaluru earlier this year, some thought they were throwing a hint.







