


INDIA TARGETS \$3-5 BILLION GREEN HYDROGEN Exports by 2030: Report

India is making strides in the green hydrogen sector, aiming to lead exports by 2030 as part of a broader strategy to reduce reliance on imported liquefied natural gas (LNG) and boost domestic GDP growth.

A report by Alvarez & Marsal underscores India's ambitious plans, projecting USD 3–5 billion in exports and USD 7–15 billion in import substitution within the next decade.

Green hydrogen, generated through water electrolysis using renewable energy, emits no carbon dioxide, aligning with global efforts for a lowcarbon economy.



hydrogen The global market is projected to reach USD 24-36 billion by 2030 due to investments in low-carbon production. India aims to lead in green hydrogen production and export, with economic and environmental benefits. Collaboration and technology are crucial for hydrogen transportation. India's proactive stance can secure a position in the green energy market competitive production with costs, showcasing commitment to combatting climate change through green hydrogen leadership.



NORWAY TO ELIMINATE CUSTOMS DUTIES FOR Almost 98 PC of Imports from India

Norway plans to remove customs duties for nearly 98% of imports from India following a trade pact.






