





AUSTRALIA OFFERS CLIMATE-RESILIENT FARMING TECH TO INDIA IN EXCHANGE FOR IMPORT DUTY CUTS

Australia has proposed aiding India in developing climate-resilient crops and grain storage technology in exchange for India's reduction of import duties on Australian agricultural imports, according to sources familiar with the matter.

Australian High Commissioner to India, Philip Green, emphasised the significance of reducing barriers to agricultural products.

Green from Australia sees mutual benefits in collaborating with India to improve agriculture, with potential for Australian food exports to support Indian industries




India is cautious However, about opening up the agricultural sector due to its reliance on farming for livelihoods. Talks for a Comprehensive Economic (CECA) Cooperation Agreement between India and Australia began in 2011, with an interim **Economic** Cooperation and Trade Agreement (ECTA) in effect since December 2022. India rejected market access demands for cheese and dairy products from the European Free Trade Association during trade discussions.



FARMER LOBBY PREVAILED AGAINST REDUCTION IN IMPORT DUTY ON RUBBE

The Centre has reaffirmed its stance against requests of the rubber lobby group regarding reducing the import duty on rubber from the current 25 percent to 15 percent.

The Union Commerce and Industry Ministry's stand is perceived as directed towards safeguarding the welfare of rubber-growing farmers.

India heavily relies on rubber imports from Southeast Asian countries like Vietnam, Malaysia, and Indonesia. The All India Rubber Industries Association (AIRIA) has been advocating for lower import duties to ease industry pressures.





With 1.3 million rubber growers nationwide, Kerala leads in production, contributing nearly 600,000 tonnes in 2022-23.

AIRIA, advocating for small and medium businesses, raises concerns about a rubber shortage in India due to limited domestic production. President Shashi Singh highlights the impact of high import duties and an inverted duty structure on local industries, calling for duty cuts. However, government official prioritizes a supporting farmers and increasing financial aid to boost natural rubber production. Initiatives include plantation, productivity funding for rubber enhancement, and research to reduce import dependence and promote growth nontraditional regions like the Northeast.
