

## INDIA REINSTATES SOLAR MODULE IMPORT RESTRICTIONS TO FOSTER LOCAL CAPACITY

In a move aimed at bolstering domestic solar manufacturing capabilities, the Indian government has announced the reinstatement of restrictions on the import of solar modules starting today, April 1, 2024.

This mandate, first introduced in 2021 under the Approved List of Models and Manufacturers (ALMM), requires solar project developers to procure modules exclusively from a pre-approved list of domestic and international manufacturers.

The move serves as a non-tariff barrier, incentivising the growth of India's solar manufacturing ecosystem.



The government initially exempted pre-March 31, 2024, solar projects from ALMM requirements for the fiscal year 2023-24. However, due to increased domestic manufacturing capacities, restrictions were reinstated without exceptions. India's solar module manufacturing capacity is at 64.5 GW and cell capacity at 5.8 GW as of December 2023. Projections suggest module capacity exceeding 150 GW and cell capacity hitting 75 GW by 2026, enhancing India's global solar supply chain position.





## INDIA'S TRADE DEPENDENCE ON CHINA & EU GROWS DESPITE EFFORTS TO CUT RELIANCE: UNCTAD REPORT

India's trade dependence on China and the European Union increased by 1.2 per cent in 2023, despite government efforts to reduce reliance on Chinese imports through schemes like the Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) and Quality Control Orders (QCOs).

This is according to estimates by the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) based on national statistics.





India's trade dependence on Saudi Arabia decreased slightly, while global trade showed a shift towards political proximity. Russia increased trade reliance on China during the Russia-Ukraine war, diverting exports due to sanctions.

The US reduced dependency on China while increasing trade with the EU and Mexico. Overall, global merchandise trade decreased by 5%, but trade in services grew by 8%. Some sectors like pharmaceuticals, transportation equipment, and electric vehicles saw increased trade value.




