INDIA TARGETS \$12 BILLION SEAFOOD EXPORTS IN NEXT TWO YEARS

India is looking to significantly boost its seafood exports to around USD 12 billion over the next two years, up from the current USD 8 billion.

The key strategy is to focus on high-end markets like the United States and Europe, according to Indian government officials.

India has emerged as the largest supplier of seafood, especially frozen shrimp, to the U.S. market.

Exports of frozen shrimp to America have doubled in eight years to reach USD 2.6 billion in 2022-23.



India's frozen shrimp exports reached USD 5.6 billion last fiscal year. To reach a USD 12 billion target, the government plans to promote value-added seafood products and sustainability practices. Shrimp farming provides jobs for 200,000 workers, mostly women.

Major markets include the U.S., Europe, China, Southeast Asia, Japan, and the Middle East. Officials address reports of labor exploitation by ensuring exporters meet international standards.




